#### Awards of up to \$2,500.00

Candidates who meet all of the following criteria are eligible:

*Origin:* Trinity County

Level: Graduating high school seniors or current undergraduate students

GPA: Not considered

Destination: A two- or four-year college, university, or vocational/trade school

Enrollment: Not considered

Field of Study: Vocational and Trade

Financial Need: Financial need will be used as a tie breaker between otherwise equal candidates *Important*: Student with the highest grades will not receive preference. Students less likely to receive merit-based scholarships, but who have demonstrated a desire to attend and succeed in college or vocational school and have at least passing grades be given preference in the award of scholarships from this fund. Students can re-apply. No preference given to past recipients.

- 2. Personal statement (see prompt on application)
- 3. Statement of financial need (see prompt on application)
- 3. Unofficial transcript
- 4. 2 letters of recommendation
