Redwood Empire Quilters Guild Fund

Grant Application

The purpose of Redwood Empire Quilters Guild is to promote the appreciation and knowledge of quilts; sponsor and support quilting activities and educational meetings; and encourage making, collecting, and conserving quilts.

This grant/fellowship is established to encourage interest and activities in the quilting arts field by supporting educational opportunities and the cost of supplies. The community outreach effort in the quilting arts is an important consideration for disbursement of these funds. Giving back to the community through charitable work and efforts to preserve the historical perspective are additional elements that may be included.

General Information:

- Grant Proposals should be submitted by:
 - 1. A nonprofit organization with tax exempt status under Section 501(c)3 of the Internal Revenue Code.
 - 2. A public benefit organization (public schools, government agencies, Indian Tribal Governments), or
 - 3. A community group with a qualified fiscal sponsor who meets 1 or 2 above.
- As an art grant, the Redwood Empire Quilters Guild grant also accepts applications from individual artists.
- Organizations/individuals with grant reports past due to Humboldt Area Foundation & Wild Rivers Community Foundation are not eligible to apply.
- Grants will not be made for the deferred maintenance or annual operating costs of public institutions, churches, and services of special tax districts, government or cemeteries.
- Grants will not pay for expenses that have already been incurred prior to the grant award.
- Grant size: up to \$2,000.00

Deadline: Applications must be emailed or postmarked by November 1, 2021
