WHAT HAPPENED IN JUNE?

- HAF distributed half a million dollars in scholarships to local students.
- Humboldt Health Foundation's Angel Fund helped support medical travel for 18 people as well as installation of a ramp for a mobile home. Its Dental Fund also helped three local children travel out of the area to receive dental care.
- The Sorensen Family Fund helped buy a heater for the Old Red Schoolhouse located on the Humboldt County Fairgrounds.
- The Women and Children's Fund helped childproof one home and buy a crib for another.
- The Emmerson Fund, which was established by Orvamae Emmerson in 2006, granted \$60,000 to Open Door Community Health.
- The Greenview Playground Project Fund granted out \$11,256 to the City of Arcata for maintenance of the fully-inclusive Greenview Playground.
